

ACIDIC

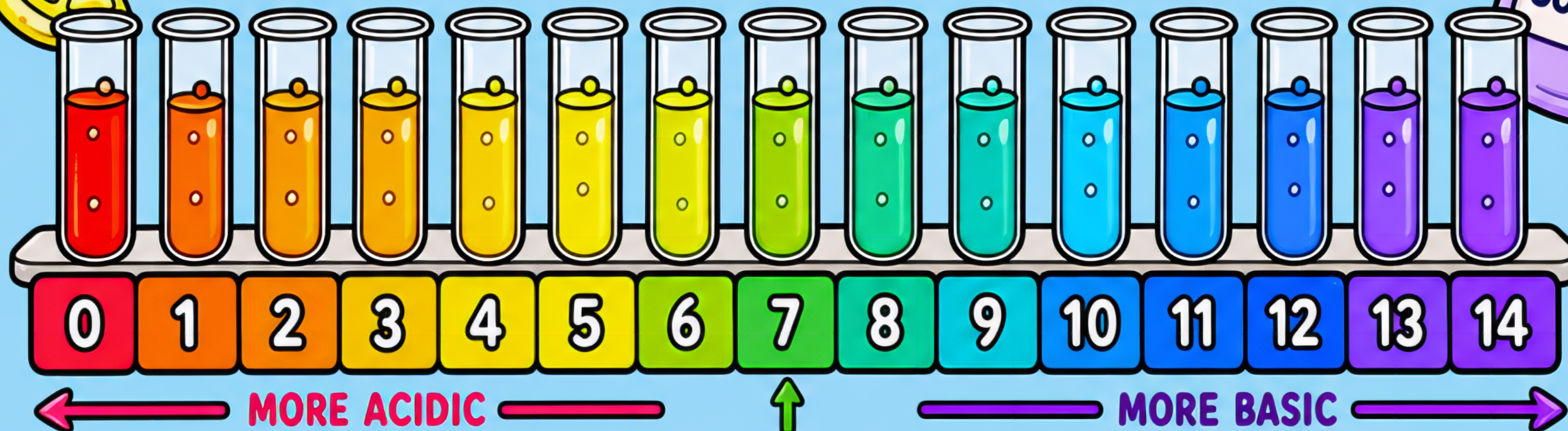
Substances with a pH less than 7 are acidic. They can taste sour and may react with certain materials.

THE pH SCALE

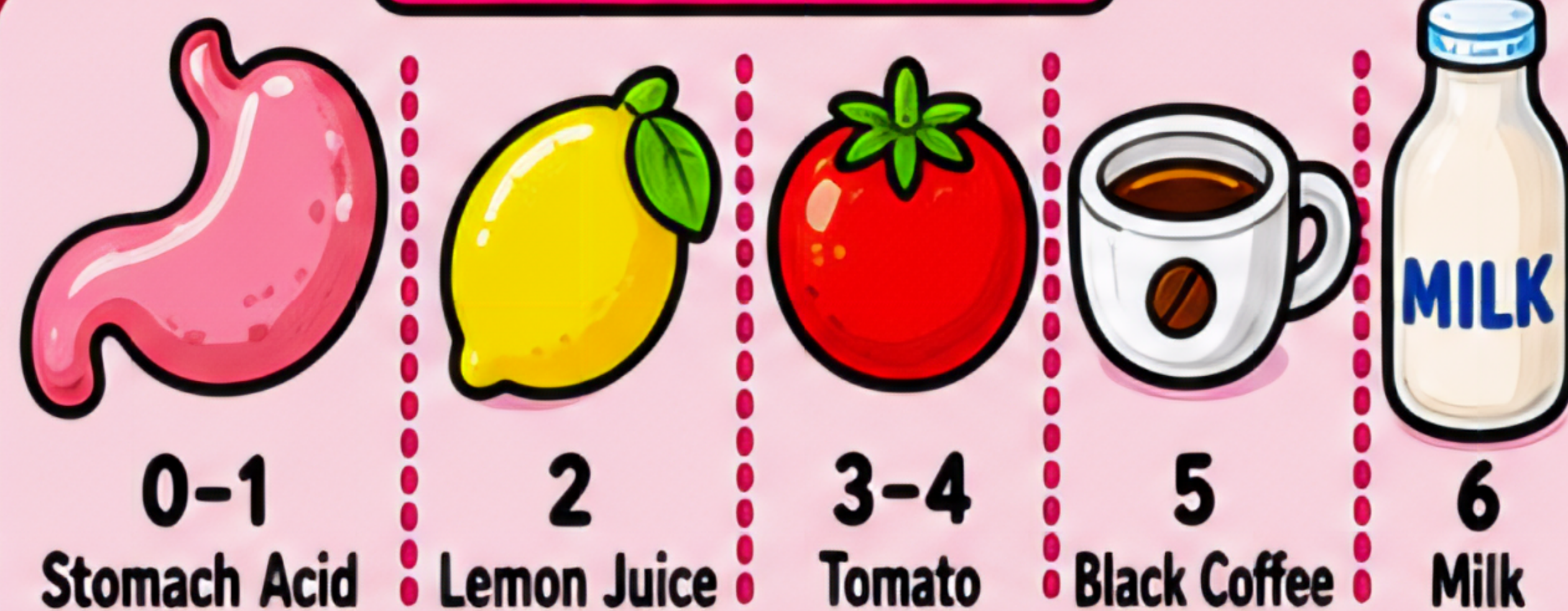
The pH scale shows how acidic or basic a substance is on a scale from 0 to 14.

BASIC (ALKALINE)

Substances with a pH greater than 7 are basic. They can feel slippery and taste bitter.



EXAMPLES OF ACIDS



NEUTRAL

pH 7 is neutral.
Pure water is neutral.
