Adjectives are words that describe nouns.

Comparative



Use comparative adjectives to compare **two** things.

They usually end in **-er**.

Example: taller, faster, cooler

Superlative



Use superlative adjectives to compare **three or more** things.

They usually end in **-est**.

Example: tallest, fastest, coolest
