Consonant-LE Syllables

A consonant-le syllable has a consonant, then -le at the end.

The -le is usually silent, but it helps make the vowel say its long vowel sound.

Examples:

table caple
bubble

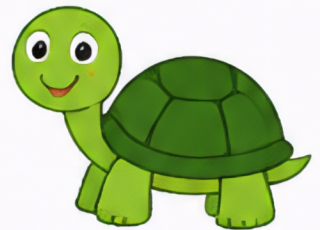
