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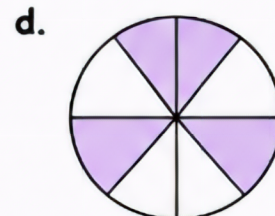
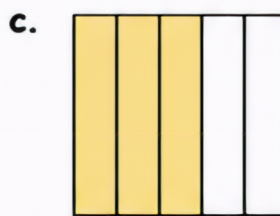
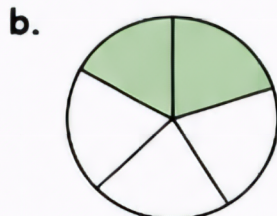
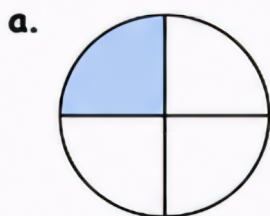
Fractions of a Whole

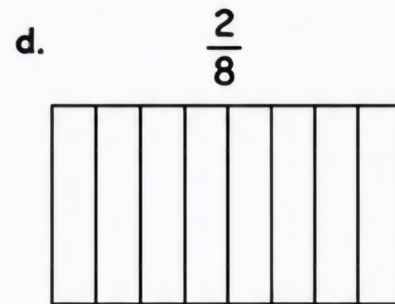
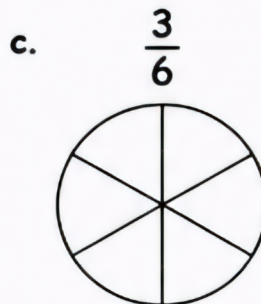
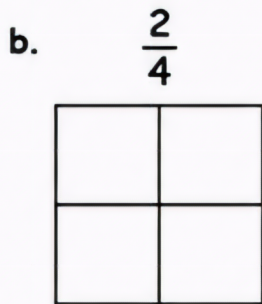
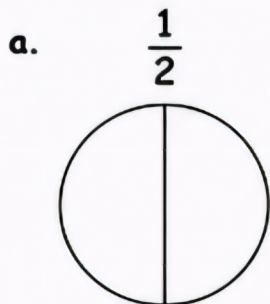
A fraction shows how many equal parts we have out of a whole.

Example: If a whole is divided into 4 equal parts and we have 1 part, that is $\frac{1}{4}$ of the whole.
