- Tomato seeds
- Small pots or seed trays
- Potting soil
- Water
- Spray bottle or watering can
- Sunny location or grow light

1. Fill pots or seed trays with moist potting soil.
2. Plant seeds 1/4 inch (6 mm) deep and cover lightly with soil.
3. Water gently.
4. Place in a warm, sunny spot or under a grow light.
5. Keep soil moist but not soggy.
6. Observe your plants each day and record their growth in the table.

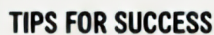
