Phonics: Magic E Syllables



What is Magic E?

When a word ends with a silent e, the e makes the vowel say its name (long vowel sound).

The e is **"magic"**!

Examples:

cap + **e** = **cape**
short a long a

kit + **e** = **kite**
short i long i

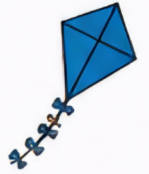
