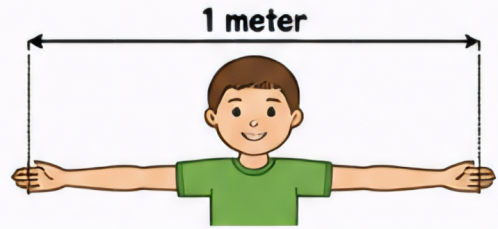

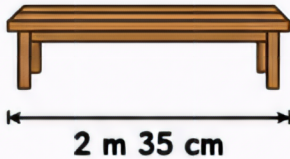
A meter (m) is a unit used to measure length.

1 meter = 100 centimeters



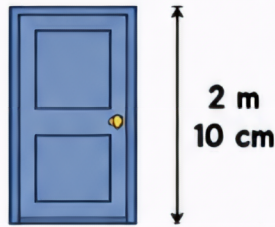

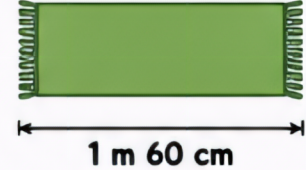
