Pronouns: Object Pronouns



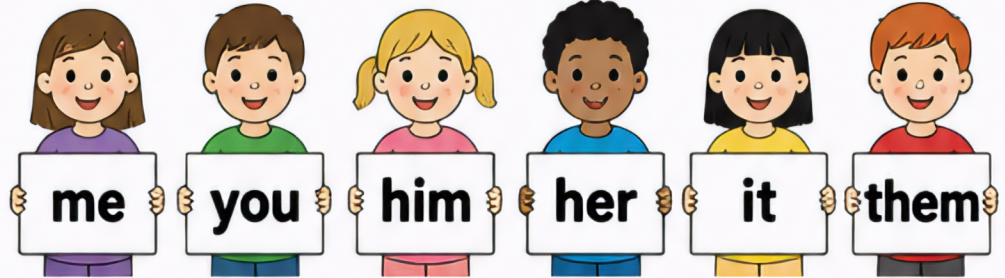
Object pronouns are used when the pronoun is the **receiver** of the action.
