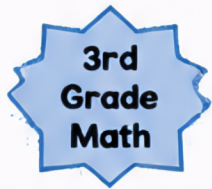

Rounding to the Nearest Hundred



What does it mean?

Rounding to the nearest hundred means finding the hundred that a number is closest to.

How do I do it?

- Look at the last two digits (the tens and ones).
- If the number is 50 or more, round up to the next hundred.
- If the number is less than 50, round down to the hundred it is in.

Examples:

252 → **300** (52 is 50 or more, so round up)

148 → **100** (48 is less than 50, so round down)
