Rounding to the Nearest Thousand



When we round to the nearest thousand, we look at the hundreds digit.

- If the hundreds digit is 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9, round up to the next thousand.
- If the hundreds digit is 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4, round down to the thousand.

EXAMPLES:

3,456 → 3,000 (hundreds digit is 4, round down)

7,893 → 8,000 (hundreds digit is 8, round up)

12,350 → 12,000 (hundreds digit is 3, round down)

9,615 → 10,000 (hundreds digit is 6, round up)
