Phonics: Soft C and G Sounds

The letter **c** says /s/ (soft c) when it comes before e, i, or y.

The letter **g** says /j/ (soft g) when it comes before e, i, or y.

Soft **c** = /s/

Examples: **city**, **celery**, **cycle**

Soft **g** = /j/

Examples: **gem**, **giant**, **ginger**
