# Temperature Reading

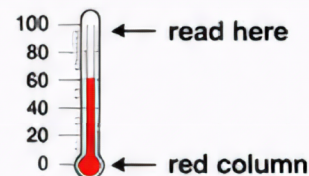
## Fahrenheit (°F)



We measure temperature in degrees Fahrenheit (°F).

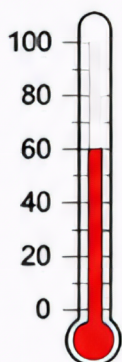
Look at the thermometer. Find the number next to the top of the red column.

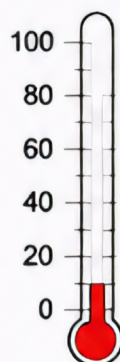

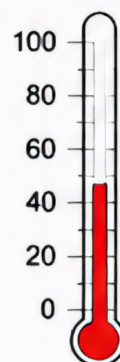
